Accommodations for January 23 to February 2, 2017

Competitors and their teams may book accommodations directly on site with Haliburton Forest checking in as early as January 23 and checking out no later than February 2, 2017.

Our housekeeping units are rustic, yet quaint two and three bedroom units as well as 2 open-loft log cabins. See attached document for dog friendly accommodations as well as our minimum number of adults per unit. For more information and to view pictures of the units please check out . The housekeeping units are within steps of the start & finish line, racer meeting room, vet station, dog yard, restaurant, etc...

Winter Camping is also available to competitors in the designated dog yard at no charge.

Arriving Before January 23?

Anyone wishing to arrive earlier is asked to contact our partnering property Limberlost Forest and Wildlife Reserve <https://limberlostforest.com/accommodations/>

Limberlost is located approximately an hour and a half north of Haliburton Forest near Hunstville, Ontario. They offer 8 lakefront lodges and cottages surrounded by extensive woodland trails to run dogs on leading up to the world championships, similar to those found at Haliburton Forest.

Bedding, kitchen and dining utensils and propane BBQ units are provided. You need only bring your own food, beverages, toiletries and towels.

Fees for Both Locations: \$75.00 per adult and \$37.50 per youth (7-17 years old) per night. Children 6 and under stay free. Youth and children fees apply as long as the minimum number of adults is met. These fees are subject to applicable taxes. At time of booking we do ask for a deposit of \$150.00 per unit on a Visa or MasterCard. All deposits are non-refundable within 15 days of the reservation date. A \$25.00 administration fee will be applied to all canceled reservations outside of the 15 days.
